Optional Boat Excursion to the islands of Murano and Burano on Day 1 (Additional \$45)

Discover the most famous islands in the Venetian Lagoon.

Murano: Explore the island of Murano, a great glass-making center since 1291, when craftsmen moved their furnaces from the center of Venice to this safer location. On a visit to a glass workshop you will understand why the name of this island is synonymous with Venetian glass and the art of glassblowing. You may want to visit the spectacular collection of the Museo del Vetro (Glass Museum), which illustrates the history of the craft from antiquity to the present.

Burano: Discover Burano, the most colorful of the lagoon islands with its brightly painted houses. It has been known for its lace industry since the 16th century. See many types of lace on a visit to the Museo del Merletto, seat of the Burano lace School from 1872 to 1970.

Conversational Italian and Culture

Course Description:

Introduction to spoken Italian providing practical use of the language with emphasis on oral-aural techniques, leading toward fluency in speaking. The goal of this course is to enhance the development of communicative competence in Italian. The emphasis of this course will be on spoken Italian and understanding written Italian as it pertains to the culture of Italy.

CEGE 690 - Cultural Immersion Experience in Italy (3-Credit Course)

Course Description:

This course coincides with an 8-day, cultural immersion experience through parts of Italy. Venice, Rome, and Florence will be explored as well as other areas. Participants in the course will gather and generate materials that can be used in their classroom, based upon their content area. During the trip, participants will journal/blog about their experience, sharing the insights they gain and reflecting upon others. Bring your cameras and your GoPros to document your experience!

The course will meet in March 2019, prior to the trip, where course expectations will be discussed and participants will become familiar with the blogging tool that will be used. Participants will blog during the trip and then there will be an additional online session after the trip to finalize the materials, complete evaluations and complete other course requirements.
