### Special Education Extension Certificate

This past June, The NYS Regents (in response to the growing shortage of certified special ed teachers) approved a new certification pathway. The EWTC, in partnership with the HRTC, is offering at **NO COST** a Special Ed Certification series beginning later this month. The program is for teachers who have a *Student with Disabilities 1-6 certification*, have a minimum of 3 years teaching experience at 5<sup>th</sup> and/or 6<sup>th</sup> grade level and want to extend their certification to Grades 7-8. There are three component courses, each 15 hours that will focus on Knowledge of Students, Instructional Strategies and Professional Practices.
