Introduction:

Lori D'Andrea welcomed and thanked everyone for attending the meeting. The Teacher Center Bylaws and the upcoming meeting dates were distributed to the Policy Board outlining their Roles and Responsibilities and the components of the Open Meeting Law.

Budget Amendment Vote

A motion was made to approve the budget amendment that was signed by our LEA and sent to Albany in October for \$545. The indirect rate for our LEA decreased from 3.1% to 2.6%, which effectively reduced our grant by \$545. An amendment was needed to reinstate this specific amount. The transfer of \$545 from Code 90 (Indirect Cost) to Code 40 (Contractual) will be used for consortium-wide PLO to be facilitated by Tawn Turnesa, a consortium teacher, from January through May. The motion was made by Michelle Kaczmarek and seconded by Kristie Martinez. All members were in favor.

Grant Course Offerings - Lori and Susan shared information on the summer and fall offerings and updated members on the upcoming winter/spring programs.

SUMMER - The Teacher Center offered 12 inservice courses (at no cost) to consortium members

- \$13,455 of the union money
- \$31,721 of our state grant money
- Approximately 225 registered for these classes

FALL - DEI Book Studies - 28 teachers participated in this book study ending tomorrow and another 28 are registered for the book club starting on Monday, November 20.
